

FALCON SPORT – SOCCER

Information Sheet for 2017

BACKGROUND

The North Sydney Boys High School Football Club (Falcon Football) celebrated its 20th season in 2013. The club was set up to provide the opportunity for students from the school to play weekend sport with their schoolmates with the ultimate aim of promoting school spirit, participation and sportsmanship.

2017 SEASON

Falcon Football offers the opportunity to play football in the Northern Suburbs Football Association (www.nsfa.asn.au) competition from April through to the end of August each year. The games are generally held on Saturday mornings throughout the season. Games will be played on the FIRST and LAST weekends of the school holidays. Parents should take this into account before registering their child.

In 2017 NSBHS plan to enter teams in each of U13, U14, U15, U16 and in U18's, as well as teams in the Men's All Age competition.

REGISTRATION & FEES

Registration fees for 2016 were \$250 for U13's (Year 7), which included NSFA fees, FFA and FNSW fees, players insurance and councils' ground fees, which represent the major proportion of the registration fee. There may be a fee increase in 2017, which will be confirmed prior to registration. Falcon Football provides playing shirts and training equipment. Players will need to supply boots, socks (same as school football) and shin-guards. We organised paid coaches for U13's, U14's and U15's in 2016. Each player paid an additional fee of approximately \$100 for coaching for the season. Fees vary based on the coach and will be communicated once coaches are allocated to teams before the season commences.

TRAINING

The school is planning for an all-weather futsal field at the school. Once completed our hope is to use this field for training either before or after school. The alternative training venue is Naremburn Park, near St Leonards. The training sessions for each team will be determined once the teams are finalised in the pre-season.

PLAYER AND PARENT INVOLVEMENT

Falcon Sport is a parent run Club. We can only run with the involvement and commitment of parents. For a team to compete parents must be committed to ensuring their child attend as many games as possible. Parents will need to be available at every game. A parent will need to act as Team Manager and other parents may be required to assist in Refereeing and Linesman roles.
