

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FALCON – BASKETBALL REGISTRATION 2019

PARENT-RUN (ALL Volunteers) , EXTRACURRICULAR SPORT PROGRAM

Falcon basketball was established to promote study-life balance such that sport and study are not mutually exclusive. It continues to be a very popular sport at the school with limited teams/ spots available to us by the Northern Suburbs Basketball Association (NSBA) in which we compete in. NSBA rationalize the number of teams to ensure all the local secondary schools are equally represented. The team coaches are selected from our current senior basketball players by way of a "Leadership Program".

In the 2019 season, Falcon Basketball will be playing in the Northern Suburbs Basketball Association (NSBA) competition. Teams of 8 – 10 players will play in Under 13, 14, 16 & 18 grades.

The 2019 enrolment process of year 7 students is by "Expression of Interest" in which players will be selected by ballot to ensure fairness and transparency. You will be notified by the convenor(s) if your application has been successful and your son will be invited to attend briefing/ training session before the start of the competition season in late January (usually Week 1 of the academic calendar).

KEY DATES:

- EOI form to be completed and received by **Friday 7 December** via email to **convenor**, not to school.
- Offers to be communicated to parents approx. **two weeks post**. Enrolments cannot be confirmed until all paperwork is complete. Second round offers to be made soon there after
- Invitation to briefing/ training session in late January (week 1 of the academic year)

All players have to must register with NSBA as a playing member before they can participate in taking the court. This annual **fee is not** included in the Falcon Basketball fee.

- **AS IT IS A PARENT-RUN PROGRAM, ONE PARENT OF THE ACCEPTED STUDENT WILL NEED TO VOLUNTEER TWO (ONE HOUR) SESSIONS ANNUALLY AS SUPERVISOR AT TRAINING AFTER SCHOOL IN OUR GYM.** And, the parents need to carry out the school gym supervisor duty (once/term) with WWCC (Work With Children Check) certificate. COMPETITION

During 2019 Falcon Basketball had 15-16 teams entered across 4 age groups (Under 13, 14, 16 and 18) in the NSBA competition.

AGE – Age groups are determined by the player's age at the **end of the calendar year** ie If the player turns 13 before 31 December 2019.They must play in the 2019 Under 14 competition.

Under 13	Competitions are of 8-10 weeks duration each term (3 per year)
Under 14, 16 & 18	Competition One runs from February to June.
Under 14, 16 & 18	Competition Two runs from July to December.

TRAINING

Over the last few years we have successfully used the services of our senior boys at the school (Year 9 and 10 Basketball players) as

coaches. Coaching takes place in the school gym and outside courts after school.

- A **team manager** is required for each team from within the ranks of the player parents. Any parent with internet access can easily fulfil this role. The manager acts as a liaison between the Falcon Sport Basketball Committee member/ Convenor/NSBA and the team, ensuring the players know what time games are and any changes to training etc. The manager role is support the Falcon coach to run the team smoothly and work closely with the committee member/ convenor 's directive to promote fairness, consistency and team spirit.
- Falcon Basketball **committee member**. We have over 160 boys playing across all the age divisions. This is only made possible from our parent volunteers. Any parents with a spare 2 – 3hours each month or at the start of each season (this will vary depending on the role) will make a difference.
